Stellar BASIC speed tests

Fast integers

In a standard number shuffling test featuring LET, some math and an IF, the system will pull over 3,000 lines of basic per second. Of course, this is using the fast integer A-Z system.

Random Pixels

In a for-next loop, the system can draw 2100 random pixels of random color per second, or over 500 random lines.

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
